Driven by a deep sense of duty, Damien abandons his career as a doctor and joins his brother, Teddy, in a dangerous fight for freedom. As bold tactics bring the British to breaking point, both sides finally agree to a treaty to end the bloodshed. But, despite the apparent victory, civil war erupts and the families find themselves pitted against one another. *2hr 07min, 15. Stars: Cillian Murphy, Pádraic Delaney, Liam Cunningham*

Moscow, 1953: when tyrannical dictator Joseph Stalin drops dead, his parasitic cronies square off in a frantic power struggle to be the next Soviet leader. Among the contenders are Georgy Malenkov, Nikita Khrushchev, and the sadistic Lavrentiy Beria. But as they brawl, and backstab their way to the top, just who is running the government? After months have passed without a culprit in her daughter's murder case, Mildred Hayes makes a bold move, painting three signs leading into her town with a controversial message directed at William Willoughby, the town's chief of police. When his second-in-command Officer Dixon, an immature mother's boy with a penchant for violence, gets involved, the battle between Mildred and Ebbing's law enforcement is only exacerbated. *1hr 55min, 15. March, 1918. C-company arrives to take its turn in the front-line trenches of northern France, led by the war-weary Captain Stanhope. With a German offensive approaching, the officers and their cook use food and the memories of their lives before the war to distract themselves, while Stanhope soaks his fear in whisky. A young officer, Raleigh, arrives fresh out of training. Each man is trapped, the days ticking by, the tension rising and the attack drawing ever closer. *1hr 47min, 12A. Elisa is a mute, isolated woman who works as a cleaning lady in a hidden, high-security government laboratory in 1962 Baltimore. Her life changes forever when she discovers the lab's classified secret -- a mysterious, scaled creature from South America that lives in a water tank. As Elisa develops a unique bond with her new friend, she soon learns that its fate and very survival lies in the hands of a hostile government agent and a marine biologist. *2hr 03min, 15.
